Bravest Football suspended operations for the 2020 season due to the Covid-19 pandemic and for the first time since 1973, there was no annual football game between FDNY and NYPD. Our focus was to keep our members safe and allow our first responders to concentrate on our mission of protecting and serving our citizens.

2021 marks the return to the field for Bravest Football as we commemorate the 20th year without our fallen brothers after the September 11th, 2001 attacks.

We honor them as we do every year - through tradition and remembrance. We immortalize them by upholding the relationships they cherished and the traditions they loved. Their photos take us out of the locker room before each game as we keep them alive and in our hearts forever.

20 years ago, following a season just like this one, quarterback Tommy Cullen, quarterback Pat Lyons, offensive tackle Durrell “Bronko” Pearsall, defensive back Tarel Coleman, defensive back Tommy Foley, tight end Keith Glascoe and kicker Billy Johnston - would be lost in the senseless attacks on September 11th 2001. These seven men would make the supreme sacrifice and never make it to the following season. Additionally, 15 Bravest football alumni would never watch a game from the stands again.

As I reflect back on the twenty years since 9/11, and my time as a coach for the Bravest football team, I realize my greatest privilege has been the countless friendships and relationships I’ve made over the years. People rarely remember the type of offense or defense you ran or what the score was in any particular year. What they do remember are their teammates, their friendships and the bonds they formed while playing for the Bravest Football team.

9/11 taught me that “living life to its fullest” is about doing what makes you truly happiest. Doing the things you are most passionate about and cherishing the people you hold dear along the way. Coaching the Bravest team has been my passion for over twenty years and I have met countless friends whose value in my life is immeasurable. By my own definition, this team has helped me embody and live this value.

I want to thank the First Responders Children Foundation, Metlife Stadium, and the numerous sponsors who helped us put together this 20th year commemoration event and made this a special day. A day of remembrance for the families of our fallen, our players, our families and our fans. I hope our brothers watching down from above are proud of this team for what it’s meant to so many along the way, keeping up with tradition, and all it has done in the name of charity.
